

The Independence City Council met for a work session in the Council Chambers at 5:30 p.m., on Monday, July 6, 2026.

Mayor Bleichner called the meeting to order with Council Members Weber, Hanna, Moore, Prusator, Mayner, O'Loughlin, and Appleby in attendance.

This meeting was available for public attendance.

Council heard updates from the Independence Fire Department, Public Library, Parks, and Recreation, and Police Department. Council held general discussion on the following topics: wastewater treatment plant replacement project funding, fire department expansion project funding, right of way abandonment on 10<sup>th</sup> Street NE, an ordinance amendment to repeal chapter 71, chapter 76 bicycle regulations, and visibility issues at the intersection of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street NE and Highway 150 North.
